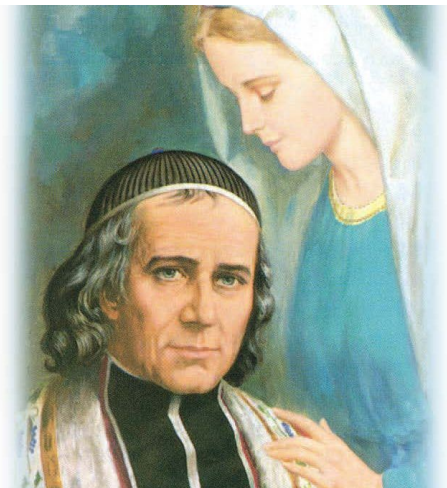


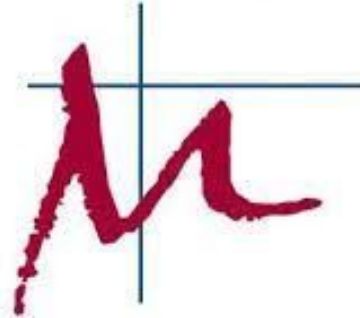


Who is William Joseph Chaminade?
